

Sevalaya competitions: Reaching great minds to young minds

The founding of Sevalaya was inspired by Bharathi, Gandhi and Vivekananda. Right from the early years, competitions were a major route to reach the messages of these great men, to children. Currently, competitions are held five times every year: on one day each that is important in the lives of the three inspirers of Sevalaya, one day to celebrate the three together and another, in memory of Bharathi and his wife Chellamma.

Spearheading the spread of moral values among children and the community at large is a Department called BGV, underscoring the influence of Bharathi, Gandhi and Vivekananda on the ethos of Sevalaya.









From 2024, to increase the reach, the contests have been revamped, with some major changes.

Decentralised organising From centrally organised contests held only at the Kasuva centre, the contests were held in 9 centres in Tamil Nadu, besides online contests for children from remote locations.

Branding All contest have been brought together, with composite and individual branding, for better recognition and aggregated familiarity.







Communication From a WhatsApp based communication, website, local whatsAap groups, social media bulk messages, mass emails and Sevalaya newsletter have been employed to spread awareness.

5-fold hike in reach Decentralisation and direct approach by Sevalaya Centres have boosted the number of participating schools and colleges to 426.


